

The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified it by his angel unto his servant John:

And these things write we unto you, that your joy 3. (1 John 1:3-4) may be full. Walking In the Light 2nd Truth: Light, the Message of Jesus This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. (1 John 1:5) A land of darkness, as darkness itself; and of the shadow of death, without any order, and where the light is as darkness. (Job 10:22) God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, and brake their bands in sunder. Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of (Psalm 107:14-15) men! The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up. From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand. (Matthew 4:16-17)

Through the tender mercy of our God; whereby the dayspring from on high hath visited us,	
the way of evil men. ed a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat. (1 Corinthians 5:11)	
To give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace. (Luke 1:78-79)	
Do not err, my beloved brethren.	
Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turn- ing. (James 1:16-17)	
But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:	
(1 Peter 2:9) If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth: (1 John 1:6)	5.
But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another	6.
Can two walk together, except they be agreed? (Amos 3:3)	
But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin. (1 John 1:7)	7.
If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. (1 John 1:8)	8.
If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us. (1 John 1:10)	
For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; (Romans 3:23)	
If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to for- give us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrigh- teousness. (1 John 1:9)	9.
Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life. (John 8:12)	10.
Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path. (Psalm 119:105)







